Percentage rate situations and other types of negotiations between landlords and tenants will likely become more common in 2021, Perna-Plank said. "Percentage rent of a tenant's sales should be structured in a way so as to keep a tenant afloat and a landlord with an occupied space," she said. "We are seeing some commercial leases where the landlord is agreeing to take only percentage rent for a few years with no base rent. For example, if annual base rent is \$100,000, a landlord might agree to 10 percent of gross sales on the first \$1 million and perhaps 2 percent thereafter, without any base rent payable under the lease."

"Commercial property owners are negotiating rent reductions, deferrals and abatements," Perna-Plank said. "At the end of the day, a stable 2021 will mean compromise."
